The Importance of Reading every night

Your child has the wonderful opportunity of learning to speak, read, and write in both French and English. The positive benefits of reinforcing these skills at home are crucial and an important key to your child's success! The BHNCDSD has purchased two reading licenses for programs that will offer your child support both in the classroom and at home to reinforce reading skills.



Lecture Enfant

Your child has access to this fabulous resource that will support them in practising French sounds, common sight words and offers full access to 18 different levels of books on a wide variety of topics! Your child will have access to audio flashcards for letter sounds and blends as well as sight words and grammar embedded stories at the bottom of the home page. Each icon on the home page is linked to the level of books. Level A books are found in Ananas.

Je lis Je lis!

Je lis is a reading license that allows your child's teacher to assign specific books at your child's reading level. The teacher is able to track the books that your child is reading at home. It is important for your child to revisit and reread the same story throughout the week to hear and practise new vocabulary and then read the story without the supportive audio playing. Your child should practise telling you what the story was about.
