




What are some initial issues you see with the existing conditions at your school?



Do you feel there is too much traffic at your school during dropoff/pickup times?





Why Should Those Areas Move/Not Move?


- There should be alignment with the City of Brantford municipal boundary for the following areas (these areas should attend a school in Brantford):

Of the two New Paris Elementary School ideas for consideration, which do you prefer more?






Why is that the preferred scenario?














Growth Areas – Our Lady of Providence Powerline West, Central and East Block Plans & Balmoral Block Plan








