




Student Distribution



Norfolk County Attendance Boundary Review Preliminary Ideas for Consideration



- Boundary Adjustment
 - Consultant thinks there is potential to move areas 4-7, 9, 15, 20-22, 24, & 25
- 2. Program Relocation
 - Expansion of the French Immersion program to under-enrolled schools (e.g., Our Lady of Fatima, Sacred Heart, St. Michael's).
 - Consider splitting the French Immersion program by grade level with an under-enrolled school: JK-3 at one school and Grades 4-8 at another.
 - Consider relocating the French Immersion program entirely to an underenrolled school and establishing a single-track French Immersion school.








- Areas 4+5+9 from St. Frances Cabrini sent to Our Lady of Fatima

- FI Program Split: 4-8 moves from St. Joseph's to Sacred Heart & JK-3 moves to St. Michael's
- St. Michael's utilization increases to 125%
- St. Bernard of Clairvaux remains above 130% utilization but has 5 portables on site to accommodate students (would only need 3)




- · Area 9 from St. Frances Cabrini sent to Our Lady of Fatima

- Areas 20+21 from St. Joseph's sent to St. Michael's
- Areas 11+17+18 from St. Bernard of Clairvaux sent to St. Joseph's
- St. Cecilia's becomes a ST-FI School
- St. Joseph's and St. Bernard of Clairvaux remain above 130% utilization
 - St. Joseph's currently has 12 portables on site (would only need 6)

Key Questions



- Which areas does the committee feel are suitable/not suitable to move?
- Are there community connections to certain areas that may allow for a more appropriate boundary change?
- Should the FI program remain status quo?
- If changes must be made to FI, what is the preferred scenario?
 - Split with junior remaining at St. Joseph and senior grades to another location?
 - Whole program moved out of St. Joseph and split between 2 new locations?
 - Whole program moved out of St. Joseph and a new single track program at a new location?

Future Discussions: Implementation Decisions



School Space Audits/Temporary spaces/Transportation

• Conduct school space audits to identify potential temporary holding spaces in under-utilized schools, such as Our Lady of Fatima CES. Ensure that these spaces are adequately prepared to receive students during transition periods or boundary adjustments. Get details on impacts to transportation/bussing times.

Staffing requirements/needs

• Evaluate staffing adjustments needed to accommodate boundary changes and program shifts, including reallocating teaching and support staff, ensuring adequate administrative support, and hiring specialized teachers for expanded programs (e.g., French Immersion).
