How to Become a School Trip Volunteer:

Don't wait until it's too late! All volunteers must have:

- A Vulnerable Sector Police Check on file (valid for 3 years)
- Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (A.O.D.A.) Training Certificate (completed online)
- Signed Volunteer Confidentiality Agreement



All 3 must be in order to attend the trip. If you would like to start the process, please contact Mrs. Andree in order to receive the electronic letter. This letter is required to obtain your vulnerable sector check online with Police Services. This process may take as long as 4–6 weeks so don't delay!

Students Absent on Hot Lunch Days

Just a reminder if your child(ren) are absent on a hot lunch day—it will **not** automatically be wrapped up or left in the refrigerator until the next day unless you **call ahead and request this**. We are not able to ensure that all students absent that day will have their lunch saved.
