Parking

Please be aware that the Bylaw officer will continue to monitor the parking throughout the year. He will be ticketing individuals who are parking in the no parking spots across the street from the school. Please remember that double parking in the parking lot is not allowed. Our kids are worth it. Park in designated areas only. YOU CANNOT DRIVE THRU OUR FRONT DRIVE. We are asking families to NOT park in the staff parking lot during drop off or pick up. We have a very large staff this year, including our YMCA program. All staff need a parking spot. If this continues to be a problem we will shut the parking lot down for parent use.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP REMINDERS

<u>Staff are outside at 8:25am</u> for you to drop off at the kindergarten area or at the front gates. Please drop your child and leave, so help with traffic congestion. At dismissal, staff will ensure that they take students outside to have a safe release to parents or an older sibling. If a student is picking up a sibling, they are to go around to their siblings designated dismissal/pick up area. To further ensure safety parents are not permitted on school property. We appreciate your understanding.

<u>INDOOR SHOES</u> While at school, all students are expected to wear a clean pair of shoes when indoors. This practice provides for a cleaner and safer school facility. We recommend that students have running shoes that can also be worn in the gym as their indoor shoes all year long.

SCHOOL CASH ONLINE—VERY IMPORTANT

We really appreciate having every family on board with this initiative. St. Gabriel School will only utilize School Cash Online as a form of payment. Sorry, **NO CASH or CHEQUES** will be accepted. Credit Cards are now accepted. Once you are registered, you can pay for field trips, hot lunches etc., for all your children at one time. You will also receive notification when an item has been placed on School Cash. Instructions to register for School Cash were emailed out to families during the first week of school.

ARRIVING LATE TO SCHOOL

Students who arrive late to school must report to the office before going to class by entering through the front doors of the school.

LEAVING FOR APPOINTMENTS

A parent/guardian who requires a student to leave the school before dismissal time must come to the office to sign the student out. Please make sure to use the Safe Arrival App to indicate that you are picking your child up early. All students must be picked up at the office. This policy is in place to ensure the safety of all students.

MEDICATION

The staff at St. Gabriel Catholic School must follow Board procedures for the administration of medication during school hours. If your child requires such medication you are asked to contact the principal, and the necessary arrangements will be made.

Authorization to provide such service must be made in writing by the parent and physician on the appropriate form (obtained at the school). Only prescription drugs will be administered. Non-prescription drugs such as aspirins will NOT be administered to the students.

NUT ALLERGY ALERT

St. Gabriel's is a NUT FREE facility.

There are students in our school with life threatening allergies to **peanuts and tree nuts**. Even a trace amount from peanut/nut products or food that has come in contact with a peanut/nut source (cross contamination) can result in a life-threatening anaphylactic reaction. The most serious reaction being respiratory difficulties, blockage of the airways, which if not medicated immediately, can lead to death.

To provide the minimized allergen environment, we need the support and cooperation of the parents/guardians and the school community. Students are asked to bring lunches and snacks free of peanuts and tree nuts as well as products that have the "may contain **peanuts/tree nuts**" warning on them. Please read labels before sending food to school. Keep in mind not all packaging is clearly labelled with the warning. Truly, this is a life saving measure. If you have caregivers who provide your child with lunches or snacks, we encourage you to share this information with them.

NUT ALLERGY HELP (Understanding what to look for.)

When identifying whether food is safe to send to school, there are few things to look for:

1. READ THE LABELS!

That means there should be **NO** tree nuts & peanuts in the ingredients.

The item should also be made in a TREE NUT & PEANUT FREE FACILITY.

The label can NOT say "May Contain Nuts" or made on equipment that also processes nuts, or anything similar.

2. DON'T BE FOOLED BY SYMBOLS!



The symbol on the left
Indicates "peanut free", but not
necessarily "tree nut" free so
please read the ingredients to be sure!

Each companies standard of school safe is different so Please read the ingredients to be sure!



Anaphylaxis Canada recommends reading all labels instead of just reading the symbols

3. Remember that peanuts and tree nuts are NOT the same thing

Peanuts: a member of the legume family and not botanically related to tree nuts.

Tree Nuts: Almonds, Brazil Nuts, Cashews, Chestnuts, Hazelnuts, Hickory Nuts, Macadamia Nuts, Pecans, Pine Nuts, Pistachios, Shea Nuts and Walnuts.

We realize this request may require added planning and effort on your part when packaging your child's lunch and snacks, however, we wish to express our sincere appreciation for your support and cooperation. We cannot guarantee a nut free environment for students nor an "allergen free" area at our school, but with your help we can make our school as safe as is reasonably possible in this regard.

Parents we have a number of students in the school who have serious allergies. In order to best ensure the students do not have an anaphylactic reaction we are insisting that no food items other than your child's lunch and snacks be brought to the school.

We will still have our hot lunches (pizza days, pita days). Children's birthdays or special occasions will have to occur at the home. I'm confident that you understand the importance of this and will support this initiative. The health and safety of all our children is most important.



STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Many families do not know that our school board does not cover accident costs! If an accident happens, the board may be prevented from offering financial solutions to our families even if we wanted to. Student accident insurance, Insuremykids®, can mitigate your board's exposure and help you manage the loss for student injuries that occur on school property or during school activities,

including extra curricular sports.

Each year, many families are left financially unprotected when their children are injured at school, while participating in non-school activities or at home. If a student is injured, parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible for any costs not covered by the Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP) or their employer's health care plan. Please check with your provider regarding your coverage.

Most accident-related expenses are not fully covered under OHIP and some expenses like ambulance fees, casts, crutches, physiotherapy and emergency dental care are usually not covered at all. This leaves you, the parent/guardian, financially responsible.

To help protect your family, it is recommended that you consider obtaining student accident insurance. As a convenience to you, the Board has arranged to offer student accident insurance through insuremykids. Participation is voluntary, but highly recommended, and the costs are to be paid by the parent/guardian. The program is available for students up to age 26.

Coverage is provided for a wide range of accidental expenses, including:

- Dental Expenses includes 10 years unlimited dental benefit coverage, future dental up to \$1,650 per tooth, and injury-related orthodontia coverage up to \$2,500 per accident.
- Total and Permanent Disability up to \$350,000.
- Loss of Limb/Loss of Sight, Hearing, or Speech.
- Accidental Death.
- Ambulance Fees.
- And much more.

Insuremykids® Student Accident Insurance offers three plans with 24/7 coverage at affordable rates – their most affordable plan is \$17 per year and their most popular plan is the Platinum at \$33 per year, which provides out-of-province emergency medical coverage and travel benefits. All annual plans provide 13 months of coverage from the date of purchase. Family rates are available for three or more children in the same family, even if attending different schools. You can also save on time and premium with an optional 3-Year or 5-Year plan, available for online purchase only.
