5.2	Capital Projects and AODA	<ul> <li>Facility Services (FS) continues to align AODA with the Board's capital plans.</li> <li>Thus far in 2023, FS have spent over \$250,000 on AODA projects, which include:         <ul> <li>AODA compliant ramp and rails at Madonna Della Libera (\$11,000).</li> <li>New doors at Assumption College (\$100,000).</li> <li>First floor washroom at St. John's College, various door operators throughout the Board and signage (\$130,000+).</li> <li>This summer FS has committed over \$500,000 in parking lot upgrades that will incorporate AODA standards (parking spots, accessible curbs, signage, etc.) at St. Bernard of Clairvaux and Christ the King Schools.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
