# 6.1 COVID Update

Director McDonald advised that schools will be sending home rapid antigen testing kits. Upon the return to school after the winter break in January, elementary students will be required to confirm screening for the first two weeks. Grade 7/8 students will be able to verbally attest. And K-6 will have a form sent home with parent signature. It was noted that high schools will be returning to a semester system on February 4, 2022.

Trustee Watson asked for student feedback on the different systems. Director McDonald noted that principals will be holding discussions with staff and students.

Vice Chair Luciani inquired as to supports being provided for students who may have a heavy course load when switching back to four courses. Director McDonald advised that a variety of supports will be made available to students leading up to the semester.

Student Trustee O'Brien noted that the guidance department is very helpful in ensuring that courses are balanced and coordinated.

Trustees extended congratulations to St. John's College students who won the team sportsmanship award at OFSAA.

Superintendent Keys provided an outline of the status of community use of school. Permits are being issued to non-profit youth groups with participants who have been fully vaccinated. User groups will be responsible for ensuring all public health and safety guidelines are adhered to. Permits will only be available on evenings during the week at this time.

# 6.1 COVID Update

Director McDonald provided a summary of the recent directives from the Ministry of Education. Staff have been provided N95 masks and masks for students are currently being distributed to schools. It was announced that some schools would be holding vaccination clinics. The board will be working with local public health units to determine locations. Students will require a signed parental/guardian consent form to attend the clinic. The Ministry also identified that we are to resume cohorting outdoors. He provided an outline of the updated COVID-19 school and childcare screening tool. All students and staff and will also be receiving two rapid antigen tests. Attendance reporting will also transition to reporting by percentage of total daily absences. This data will be posted on the board website.

Student Trustee O'Brien asked about the impact of online learning for high school students in the past two weeks upon the return from winter break. Superintendent Temple advised that principals have been reminded to extend compassion while conducting assessments and evaluation and highlight the importance of demonstrating learning.

# STUDENT TRUSTEE REPORT

Public Session

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

At the January senate meeting, we had a Student Demographic Survey presentation where we were asked to give suggestions for how we could increase student participation in the survey. Some of the suggestions to increase participation in the survey included giving kids rewards (e.g., extra dress down days), staff promotion, and a promotional video. We were also asked if we thought that it should be called a census or survey. Follow up consultation is being planned.

The Student Senate group volunteered at St. Vincent de Paul in December. Hopefully we will be able to volunteer again when restrictions lift.

# **DEVELOPMENTS:**

It was very clear that kids were happy to be back at school again but stressed about how the online learning would affect their grades. To help with this, Superintendent Temple sent out an email to principals asking the secondary teachers in the board to exercise empathy and be considerate and compassionate when it comes to culminating activities and marks this quad.

#### **SCHOOL NEWS:**

At Assumption College school they hosted coffee house and karaoke night. Both events were a big success, and it was encouraging to see the community coming together for events again. They also had spirit week leading up to Christmas. On the last day of school before Christmas break, Assumption had a liturgy, and the student council ran events such as Kahoot trivia over teams for all classes. They also ran their Pennies for Heaven campaign which raised over \$8000.

Holy Trinity hosted an outdoor student council retreat in November. The principal at the school allowed them to host the school's traditional turkey dinner subject to all required COVID food handling protocols and the selling of candy grams was a success. They also had a very successful spirit month in December and are working on planning for Black History month.

St. John's College school had a very successful countdown to Christmas this December and actively posted on there Instagram account throughout the extended break. They are currently planning a mental health promotion as we approach exams. They are also planning to run a matchmaker activity on Valentine's Day.
