5.2 English-as-a-Second Language (ESL) Staffing / English Language Learner (ELL) Support for Semester #2

She also noted that funding is available to support the hiring of a System Teacher and ESL/ELL support staff.

6. Information and Correspondence

6.1 Superintendent Temple presented an update on the Tutoring Support opportunities that were offered between September and December 2022 within the Brant Haldimand Norfolk Catholic District School Board. The primary goals are to offer tutoring that is flexible and accessible for families, covers all grade levels and subject areas, offers in-person as well as virtual opportunities, while engaging community partners. The next steps are to build on support for ESL students, further promote small group in person opportunities at secondary and elementary levels and broaden the use of Knowledgehook for support in numeracy.

Trustee Chop inquired if transportation at the end of the school day was limiting students from participating in the in-person tutoring. Superintendent Temple confirmed that accommodations are being met where requested. Superintendent Temple also noted that most families enjoy the virtual option as they can participate when it works best for them. Trustee Blake inquired about the breakdown of families participating within the multiple geographical locations of the Board. Superintendent Temple is going to report back.

Some employees, depending on the job requirements, are currently working under an operating procedure that was developed during the pandemic. This operating procedure provides eligible employees based on their job requirements, the option of working remotely a maximum of 1-2 days per week. A Remote Work Policy has recently been developed and will be reviewed in February 2023 at Policy Committee.
