DEVELOPMENTS:

SCHOOL NEWS:

At St. John's College, April has been a fairly quiet month. On Wednesday April 10th, students and staff at SJC celebrated the Easter season with an Easter Mass. The school Chaplain has organized the SJC grad retreat, which will take place on Friday April 26, at Camp Marydale, in Hamilton. SJC's student council has been busy throughout the month, planning various other activities for the student body.
