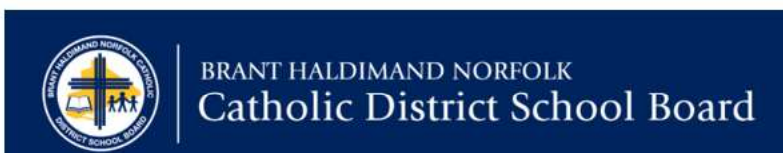

Elementary Curriculum Continued Changes for 2026-2027:

Early reading screening tools, Acadience Screener, The Phonics Companion and Heggerty pre-Kindergarten Program; The Phonics Companion (Grade 1 and 2); FlyLeaf (Grades 1-3); Empower Reading; KeyMath 3 diagnostic Assessment and Essential Resources to develop intervention programs/activities/materials for students on a modified math program. These programs will be continuing.
